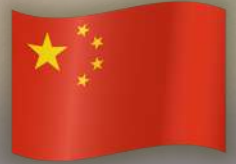
I expect that the launch of the intellectual and sports game “Fatum” will give a new impetus to strategic interaction on the platform of BRICS.
